When prescribing antidepressants for their bipolar patients, psychiatrists mainly are concerned about "mood switching," which is when a depressive mood suddenly switches to mania, hypomania or a mixed state. Do not routinely offer social skills training as a specific intervention to people with psychosis or schizophrenia.
