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Adjustment schedule is as follows. Dosage adjustment should be guided by clinical outcome. Blocks sodium channels, enhancing the action of gamma-amino butyrate a neurotransmitter ; also inhibits amino acid excitatory receptors. Carbonic anhydrase inhibitors, such as acetazolamide and dichlorphenamide: Report significant adverse reactions. Titrate dosage over 5 to 7 weeks, with total maximum daily dosage based on weight. Report new seizure types or worsening seizure pattern. Overdose and treatment In acute overdose after recent ingestion, institute gastric lavage or emesis. Instruct patient how to recognize and immediately report signs and symptoms of hyperammonemia and metabolic acidosis. Adjust up to maximum daily dose of mg in two divided doses. Instruct patient to swallow mixture immediately without chewing sprinkles.
