Tamiflu should not be used in place of getting a yearly flu shot. Do not use this medication to prevent influenza in a child younger than 1 year old. Anyone using Tamiflu should be watched closely for signs of confusion or unusual behavior, especially a child. However, not receiving this medication to prevent influenza could be harmful to the baby if the mother becomes infected with a disease that Tamiflu could prevent. Call your doctor for medical advice about side effects. Throw away any unused liquid after 17 days. Do not use this medication to treat influenza in a child younger than 2 weeks old. Some people using Tamiflu have had rare side effects of sudden confusion, shaking, problems with speech, hallucinations hearing or seeing things that are not there , or seizure convulsions. Take Tamiflu for as many days as it has been prescribed for you even if you begin to feel better. Tamiflu is used to treat influenza in people 2 weeks of age and older who have had flu symptoms for 2 days or less. If you do not have a dose-measuring device, ask your pharmacist for one. Swallow the mixture right away without chewing. It is not known whether oseltamivir passes into breast milk or if it could harm a nursing baby. Tamiflu oseltamivir is an antiviral medication that blocks the actions of influenza virus types A and B in your body.
