Jan 15, - Follow the directions on your prescription label or the package label carefully, and ask your doctor or pharmacist to explain any part you do not understand. Use permethrin exactly as directed. Do not use more or less of it or use it more often than prescribed by your doctor. Permethrin should only be used. You need to dilute it half and half with a carrier oil, to make it 5% permethrin, exactly the same dosage as the prescription 5% cream.
