The main disadvantage however, is that patients can be allergic to penicillin based materials with a severe anaphylactic reaction occurring. Bacteraemia is a condition in which bacteria are present in the blood and may cause disease, including systemic disease such as infective endocarditis. However, according to new recommendations from the National Institution for Health and Care Excellence NICE, antibiotic prophylaxis should not be offered for all patients at risk of infective endocarditis. Antibiotics are no longer used as prophylactic treatment of infective endocarditis in the UK, however, Amoxicillin was once used for prophylaxis of infective endocarditis in patients who have undergone oral surgery or deep scaling. Amoxicillin is still the first-line drug of choice but with 34% of Prevotella species resistant to amoxicillin, the alternatives of amoxicillin/clavulanate, clindamycin, and metronidazole need to be considered.
