Affected breeds include Collies and Collie-type breeds as well as Australian Shepherds, Old English Sheepdogs, and Shetland Sheepdogs just to name a few. Known side effects associated with Imodium A-D are drowsiness (sedation) and dizziness. Much more serious symptoms can occur, meaning high toxicity whereby death is possible, for certain dog breeds. It's fine with most dogs, the retriever in your avatar - but not with herding breeds as they may be sensitive to the ivermectin in immodium - so don't give to shelties, border collies, rough/smooth collies, german shepherds, aussie shepherds, lancashire heelers, tollers, or other herding or related herding. Loperamide (Imodium) can be given if the diarrhea doesn't resolve easily; caution is required when using this OTC medication in Collies, and don't use it for more than five days.
