Dosage and duration of treatment One orlistat capsule is taken with water immediately before, during or up to one hour after, each main meal up to a maximum of three capsules a day. Moderate-intensity activity is any activity that increases your heart and breathing rate, such as: See your GP before starting treatment with orlistat if you have another serious health condition, such as type 2 diabetes, high blood pressure, or kidney disease, which you're taking medication for. You can only use orlistat if a doctor or pharmacist thinks it's the right medicine for you. A responsible diet programme should: There's no single rule that applies to everyone, but to lose weight at a safe and sustainable rate of 0. This could include things like: When orlistat should be used Orlistat will usually only be recommended if you've made a significant effort to lose weight through diet, exercise or changing your lifestyle. The amount of calories your child should eat each day will depend on their age and height. Consult your doctor or pharmacist, as it may be necessary to stop your treatment. The generic version of Nurofen, Tablets containing orlistat are available on the NHS, but are typically only prescribed to people with a BMI over 30 who have exhausted other weight loss techniques.
