

## do i need a prescription for depo provera

You can visit your doctor or your nearest Planned Parenthood health center to get the shot. How much does the birth control shot cost? The birth control shot (sometimes called Depo-Provera, the Depo shot, or DMPA) contains the hormone progestin. Progestin stops you from getting pregnant by preventing ovulation. When there's no egg in the tube, pregnancy can't happen. It also works by making cervical mucus thicker. When the mucus on the cervix is. Depo-Provera works for about 3 months at a time. To prevent pregnancy, you have to get 1 shot from your doctor 4 times a year, about 12 to 14 weeks apart. If you get it in the first 7 days of your cycle, it works right away. If you don't, you'll need to use another form of birth control for 1 week. Your doctor will confirm you are not.
