To prevent constant stimulation once the ACh is released, an enzyme called acetylcholinesterase is present in the endplate membrane close to the receptors on the post synaptic membrane, and quickly hydrolyses ACh. Pyridostigmine inhibits acetylcholinesterase in the synaptic cleft, thus slowing down the hydrolysis of acetylcholine. Maximum plasma concentrations occur at 1 to 2 hours and it is eliminated by the kidney largely unchanged with a half-life of 3 to 4 hours. Indications. Myasthenia gravis; paralytic ileus; postoperative urinary retention. Dosage and Administration. MESTINON tablets. Children under 6 years old should receive an initial dose of half a tablet (30mg) of Mestinon; children 6 - 12 years old should receive one tablet (60mg). Dosage should be increased gradually, in increments of 15 - 30mg daily, until maximum improvement is obtained. Pyridostigmine is medication used to treat myasthenia gravis. It is also used together with atropine to end the effects of neuromuscular blocking medication of the non-depolarizing type. It is typically given by mouth but can also be used by injection. The effects generally begin within 45 minutes and last up to 6 hours.
