It is the active ingredient in many household foggers, crop sprays, flea dips for pets and lice shampoos for people, as well as in sprays and soaks meant for clothing, mosquito nets and tents. A dozen years ago, the National Academy of Sciences convened a panel to weigh the health pros and cons of issuing soldiers combat uniforms that had been pretreated with the insecticide permethrin. Unlike DEET or other repellents thought to confuse biting insects by masking carbon dioxide in breath and other body odors, permethrin is thought to stun or kill the bugs by disrupting their nervous systems when they bite something coated with the chemical or, perhaps, just get close to it. When you spray the Permethrin on, you want to position the sprayer 6 to 8 inches away from the clothing you plan to treat. Pay particular attention to the cuffs of long pants and shirt sleeves where ticks will try to attack you. It's also a good idea to spray it on your hat or to buy one that's already been treated with Permethrin. The public can purchase new insecticide-treated clothing or mail in their own clothing and have it treated. Only permethrin products labeled for treating clothing or other fabrics are used and the label instructions must be strictly followed. Insecticide-treated clothing is washed separately from other clothing, to limit the amount.
