Why It Is Used Betamethasone and dexamethasone are corticosteroids, also called glucocorticoids, that are given before birth antenatally to speed up a preterm fetus's lung development. Even though it may be rare, some people may have very bad and sometimes deadly side effects when taking a drug. Betamethasone and dexamethasone cause an immature fetus's lungs to produce a compound called surfactant.
