In rare cases, individuals may experience the discontinuation syndrome even when the medication is being tapered gradually; in such cases, an extremely slow and gradual taper will be necessary. These symptoms usually start anywhere from one day to one week after the medication was stopped, and can persists for days or even weeks. Rare fatalities have been reported with Citalopram. Escitalopram may have lower rates of sexual side-effects - like reduce libido, impotence, and ejaculation disorder - than other antidepressants. Escitalopram should not be used during or within 14 days following the administration of an MAOI, because a hypertensive crisis may result. When wanting to stop this medication, the dose should be decreased gradually over a period of weeks.
