Remeron operates by increasing the release of serotonin and norepinephrine, two brain chemicals related to depression. This is why some doctors may start a person at a higher dose of 30mg to minimize the sedative effect. You are also advised to avoid benzodiazepines, which are sometimes prescribed for anxiety, seizure, and insomnia because they can also increase these effects.
